

List of Approved Livestock Products without Approval Identifiers July 8, 2010

The Veterinary Drugs Directorate approves drugs for use in food-producing animals, the Canadian Food Inspection Agency approves feeds and veterinary biologics (e.g. vaccines), and the Pest Management Regulatory Agency registers pesticides. Most approved products have a Drug Identification Number (DIN) on their labels or a Registration Number (Pest Control Products Act); however, the Canadian Quality Milk program recognizes that some approved products do not have either number on their labels.

Generally, products or substances that do not have a DIN or Registration Number are listed in:

- The Compendium of Veterinary Products; or,
- The Permitted Substances Lists for Livestock Production (CAN/CGSB-32.311-2006).

The following list is intended to provide producers, Provincial Coordinators and validators with a quick reference for approved products whose approval may be difficult to determine on farm. Substances on the Permitted Substances Lists are not re-listed here. Please note: this list is not all inclusive and it will be up-dated as other products are identified. Descriptions of products found on farm without DINs should be submitted to a Provincial Coordinator, so that CQM can consider adding them to this list.

Products are listed in alphabetical order. A list of Veterinary Natural Health Products follows this list.

- **Aluspray** (Vétoquinol): does not have a DIN but it is in the Compendium of Veterinary Products and categorized as an Aerosol Bandage.
- **Dr. Naylor® Teat Dilators** (Dr. Naylor): does not have a DIN but it is in the Compendium of Veterinary Products.
- **Emerald** – CNF 71814 (ABS Canada): notified through the Cosmetics Division of Health Canada. Please note: this product is a teat conditioner but not a teat sanitizer.
- **Emerald Plus** – CNF 71816 (ABS Canada): notified through the Cosmetics Division of Health Canada. Please note: this product is a teat conditioner but not a teat sanitizer.
- **Emerald Indicator** – CNF 71817 (ABS Canada): notified through the Cosmetics Division of Health Canada. Please note: this product is a teat conditioner but not a teat sanitizer.
- **Intracell™ Wound Dressing** (Macleod Pharmaceuticals, Inc.): does not have a DIN but it is in the Compendium of Veterinary Products.
- **Lactofam™** – CNF 82160-0 (DeLaval). Please note: this product is a teat cleanser but not a teat sanitizer.

- **OrbeSeal®** (Pfizer Animal Health): does not have a DIN but it is in the Compendium of Veterinary Products and categorized as a Veterinary Device.
- **Original Udder Balm** – CNF 20562 (Bio Sentry Products).
- **Prima™** – CNF 98181-0 (DeLaval). Please note: this product is a teat cleanser but not a teat sanitizer.
- **Udder Comfort Spray** – CNF 155682 (Udder Comfort).
- **Udder Comfort Sprayable** – CNF 124318 (Udder Comfort).
- **Udder Comfort Udder Lotion** – CNF 124317 (Udder Comfort).
- **Udder Comfort Udder Lotion Arg** – CNF 133038 (Udder Comfort).
