## **GPA Procuring Hope for MC8**

Key WTO ambassadors met on October 6<sup>th</sup> to continue their regular brainstorming on the agenda for the December 15–17 Ministerial Conference (MC8). The goal, as per usual, was to confirm decisions on possible elements to be tackled by ministers this year and to define a Doha work programme for 2012.

Countries who aim to save the WTO's credibility from the potential collapse of the Doha Round – the so called "Friends of the System" which includes countries such as Australia, Canada, Chile, Hong Kong, Korea, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, New Zealand, Norway and Singapore – have floated ideas on topics that could be dealth with as priorities in December.

Among those are the current state and future work on the Doha Development Agenda, which needs guidance from Ministers, the so-called 21<sup>st</sup> Century issues and the Agreement on Government Procurement (GPA).

This last issue seems to be the only topic to have generated some progress as involved countries in the GPA negotiations pledged, on October  $6^{th}$ , to do whatever it takes to reach a deal on revised GPA at the MC8.

The group's next meeting is scheduled for later this week. The chair, Swiss official, Nicolas Niggli, hopes to finalise all market access offers by the end of November, in time for final review before submission to Ministers. Like most delegates, the Swiss official thinks an accord on GPA could help save an otherwise eventless Ministerial Conference.

All other topics discussed by ambassadors this past week have not produced any tangible progress, officials said. Differences still persist on what would be contained in an "early harvest" package for poorest Members, even though agreement seems to emerge on the need to have one in December.
